of the said County as they shall come to your knowledge
according to Law; you shall not advise or be of Council with
any person or persons against his Lo^p in any matter or thing
tryable in the said County you shall endeavour truely to keep
his Lo^{ps} Right and all that belongeth to him in the said
p. 145 County, you shall not assent to decrease, lessen or conceal
any of his Lo^{ps} Rights or Franchises in the said County or
whensoever you shall have knowledge that his Lo^{ps} Rights
have been concealed or withdrawn bee it in Lands, Rents,
Franchises or Suites or any other things in this County afore-
said you shall to your true power make them to be restored
to his Lo^p again and if you may not do it you shall certifie his
Lo^{ps} Justices of the Peace of the said County and his Lo^{ps} Attor:
Gen^{ll} of the Province, and further you shall use yourself in
the Office of Attorney for his Lo^p for the County aforesaid
according to the best of your skill & knowledge

March 24th 1687/8.

This day at the house of M^r Charles Hutchins in Nanticoke
upon a Treaty with the Empr^r concerning the murther of
Enock, the Empr^r did acknowledge about four dayes since he
did hear of it (but was from the Town a hunting) and that
Annachohill or the White Indian and Sonan called in English
