The Petition granted and Ordered that the Petitioner have Execution for the Fees accruing to the said Office untill the arrivall of S^r Thomas Lawrence into the Province, and that for what he hath since done and acted in that Office S^r Thomas Lawrence pay and satisfy unto him what he shall reasonably Deserve.—

That whereas your Petitioner is yet a Prisoner at S^t Marys and like so to remain and not only so but also likely to perish by reason of want, wherefore your Petitioner does humbly crave your Excellencys consideration in this case, and grant that your Petitioner may be returned a Prisoner into the County of Somerset to give Bail as is required

Upon a Petition this day preferred to this Board for and in behalf of William Morris of Somerset County a Prisoner in the Custody of the Sheriff of S^t Marys County Ordered that the said Morris paying or securing to be paid his fees due for his Imprisonm^t &^a and also the charge of his transportation hence into Somerset County may have the Liberty of being transported thither into the Custody of the Sheriff of the said County there to remain untill he shall find good Security for his good behaviour and appearance at the next Provinciaall Court to answer what shall be laid to his charge
