John LLewellin humbly moves the Board that whereas heretofore his Lordship the right Hon^{ble} the Lord Baltemore upon the humble Petition of Audry Cocks formerly the Widow and Relict of Will^m Cocks deceased and now wife to him the said John LLewellin, had granted unto her as of his free Gift a certain tract of Land q^t 500 Acres lying in Langfords Bay in Kent County late the Land of the said William Cocks decd but Escheatable to his Lordship for want of heirs of the said decd provided the same should be found accordingly to Escheate to his Lordship and that in order thereunto his Lordships Writ of Mandamus had issued to make Enquiry into the premises, that by Virtue thereof a Jury of Inquest had been summoned who had been upon the premises and upon due Enquiry thereinto had returned to the Iustices of the Provinciaill Court that the same was Escheatable and did become Escheate to his Lordship for want of heirs of the said Cocks whereupon the said Iustices of the Provinciaill Court did accordingly adjudge and condemn the same to his Lordship according to form but upon the late Revolution and before the same came to be entred upon Record the Inquisition aforesaid taken and returned as aforesaid with the Iudgment of the Provinciaill Court thereupon indorsed as aforesaid happened amongst other Writings and Papers to be mislaid and put out of the way without any Entry upon Record thereof made, the said John LLewellin upon diligent search in the Office amongst the Records and papers thereof having since found the same humbly prays an order of this Board for entry thereof upon the Records of the said Provinciaill Court in its proper place in order to obtain Patent for the same according to his Lordships Grant aforesaid; which was accordingly allowed of and ordered to be done
