I have lately received a Letter from the Lords of his Maties most honoble Privy Councill (Coppy whereof I herewith send you) Therein I am commanded to acquaint you of the greate Blessing God Almighty has bin pleased to give unto his most sacred Maty and his Royall Consort the Queen in the Birth of a hopefull son, and to his Maties dominions in a prince; you are therefore upon sight thereof to cause notice to be given by proclamacon through out my province of the birth of the prince and therein to appoynt perticuler dayes for a solemne thanksgiving to Almighty God for soe greate and innestimable a blessing, requiring the same to be performed throughout Maryland with as greate expressions of joy as the people of that Province are capable of, and you will doe well to get an addresse to be sent by the very first oppertunity for me to present to his Maty the same to be signed by the most substantiall Inhabitants there, soe not doubting of your ready and exact Complyance pursuiant to their Lords<sup>pps</sup> directons herein I rest
