Ordered also that the Neighbouring Govern^{ts} of New York & Virginia be also made acquainted with the foregoing Acco^t & proceedings of this Board concerning the Foreign Indians & that his Exc^{ly} the Governor be humbly desired to perform

At a Court held at Waring Town the 7th day of February In the Year of our Lord God one Thousand Six Hundred Ninety and Two and in the 5th Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord and Lady King William & Queen Mary by the Grace of God King and Queen of England, Scotland France & Ireland Defenders of the Faith &c^a by the Iustices thereunto authorised & appointed together with the most Principal Freeholders thereunto called for the laying out of Parishes on the West Side of Pottuxent River in Calvert County in obedience to an Act of Assembly Intituled an Act for the Service of Almighty God and the Establishment of the Protestant Religion in this Province made at the City of S^t Marys the 10th day of May Anno Dom 1692
