I am very sorry I should fall under your Excellencys displeasure in the matter of the Agreement between S Thomas Lawrence and Mr Taillard Sr Thomas came to me and said he had occasion to see the said Agreement I shewed it him he desired he might have it home with him I scrupled that, he told me he would not keep it to my Prejudice in the least I took his Honours word and gave it him I meetes with Mr Taillard and told him he said I must either get the Originall or an Authentick Copy I told Mr Taillard I would do the one or the other I went to Sir Thomas he was unwilling to part with the Original but a Copy Mr Taillard should have I told S'Thomas if he pleased I would Copy it out he anp. 171 swered no he would Copy it out himself and did so and set his hand to it as a true Copy & I another examin'd it with the Original and can both attest it as a true Copy under both our hands & Oaths also if Required this was delivered Mr Taillard which I then thought & hoped was Indifferent well to solve me for any breach of Trust against Mr Taillard but after I had waited upon your Excellency I found it would not do I went therefore to Sir Thomas and at two Several times urged his Honour with his Promise of not keeping the Original to my Prejudice which I now found would be so if he did not deliver it me he answered me he had given a Copy attested for true under his own hand and that he did not find himself Obiged any further but if Mr Taylard would come to him he would shew him the Original and give him another Copy which he should himself witness was a true one of which I told Mr Taylard which was the most I could get from Sr Thomas for my Indemnity I therefore beseech your Excellencys pardon in this matter and for this present trouble to your Excellency & subscribe
