Yours of the 3<sup>d</sup> of April last with Copy of the Queens Letter of the 11<sup>th</sup> day of October Inclosed hath been laid before us the Contents of both we have duly & maturely Considered & in Obedience to her Majestys Commands as well as our own inclinations to serve your Exc<sup>lley</sup> & their Majestys Subjects of your Gov<sup>t</sup> against the Common Enemy we have Concluded on Contributing to your aid & assistance the Sum of three hundred Pounds Sterl our Quota proportionable to our Neighbours of Virginia who are double the Number & upwards of Taxables with us Bills for which will be remitted, & your Excellency may expect by the honble Coll<sup>o</sup> Hamilton upon his return to his Gov<sup>t</sup> & we hope it with what you may receive from other parts will have good Effect to the Security & Safeguard of yours & all others their Majestys Neighbouring Collonies & Plantations we are
