by he said it would not be Long before he should see the best Liber K. part of those now in Power turn'd out with other expressions p. 265 a little while after Came in Mr Moreene & immediately he said Keech I have one Question more to ask you I askt him what that was pray what Reason had you to drink Collo Clarks health in a way to Deride me indeed Collo I do not Remember such a thing done by me with God damn you here is one in our Company will own it to your Face well if it was so I hope it is no treason my wife Standing by hearing of him Charge me she was a going to tell him that-M' Moreene was the first as was heard to say so immediately he rose up & Called me pitiful Shiting puppity Dog & that he had made us all men with his fist at my nose I did not know but he would have injured me Whereupon I did hit him he askt me to go out & therewith much ill Language with his fist at my Face again I hot him two Blows of the Face again in vindication of my Self he told me he would fight me with his Sword I told him I had no sword about him in we went & sate down again pray said Collo Iowles Mr Askey tell me who gave the abuses here indeed said M Askey you abused Keech the Collo said God damn you, you pitiful Shitten Dog whereupon Mr Askey went his way & I went home with my wife and further saith not Given under my hand this 24th day of August 1693
