I have writt to your hon' by Coll Jowles but know not it will come to hand but I make bold to write to yo' hon' of my proceedings now intended I sent the Coppy of the Indians Examinacon the which I had from M' Addison sent to me and I sent it to Coll Jowles to be sent to your hon' and also a Letter to your hon' Concerning the disturbances of the people in our parts and at the Easterne Branch I also am getting the matter of tenn or twelve men and Armes to goe to the piscattaway fort to desire the Indians to keep the fort till things were settled and Examined further And also to go up towards the Easterne Branch That the Virginians may not have any just cause to come over If your hon' thinks good send your order whether or know There is a bad report of yo' hon' concerning the hiring of the Indians to kill the protestants but I hope it is
