 Upon the hearing of the parties on both Sides in this Cause in the presence of Thomas Warr It appeared to the Court y^t the Complayn^{ts} Suit against the Def^t is for twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco and Cask for which the Decedent George Manners had a Judgment formerly against the Said Warr, concerning which 1200^l of Tobacco and Caske Marks Pheipo was bound to Save the Said Warr harmless as appeared by a Note under the Said Pheipo's hand now produced, It is therefore Ordered, that the Complayn^{ts} Suit ag^t the Def^t be dismiss^t She being at liberty to proceed upon the Said Judgment against Warr who is also to have relief against Pheipo upon his Counter Security.
