C. major and if more a surgeon General to have the whole Direction of forming hospitals &c: The English troops where a regiment when compleat, which is very seldom the Case, consisting not above 600 men have a surgeon and a mate sometimes 2 according to emergency: I therefore take the liberty to offer to your consideration whether you would not think it requisite to appoint yet another Surgeon more:

Ordered That the Committee of observation for Baltimore County be requested to collect all the public Arms in their County, and where any of them have been delivered into the Hands of Individuals out of Repair and have been put into good Order and made fit for service by them at their own Expence, that the said Committee transmit an Account of the same to the Council of Safety with the necessary Expences incurred, that such Individuals may be reimbursed out of the public Treasury, unless otherwise agreed at the Time of such Delivery. Also to attend particularly to those Arms which are still out of Repair and to have them put into good Order as soon as possible and as early as they conveniently can to furnish the Council with a State of the Whole. And that the said Committee deliver such of the said Arms as are fit for Service, and others as they are repaired to Major Gist or his Order.
