I have had an offer from the Northward but must confess I rather chuse to go from Maryland, I therefore refus'd the offer, untill I could have an answer from Annapolis. I some time ago inclos'd to the Hon<sup>le</sup> The Counsel of Safety, a recommendation from Doctors Cadwallider, Bond and Shippin of Philad<sup>a</sup> should be glad if you would inclose it to me, as it will cost me some trouble to obtain a second.
