Virginia Northumberland County Aug 21<sup>st</sup> 1776.

Gentlemen: I have delivered to M<sup>r</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Walker at the request of Capt Nicholson, four hundred and thirty two half barrels of Gun-powder, eighteen chests of Arms, loose muskets and twenty pieces of oznaberg. M<sup>r</sup> Walker tells me he received only 431 half barrels of powder, the persons I entrusted to deliver it are certain they delivered the whole quantity. I hope it will be found right.
