This house does giue Notice that a Cōmittee for Inspecting
of Acc^{ts} will goe forth on Monday next and all persons con-
cerned are hereby Ordered to prepare all Matters of Acc^{ts}
they haue to bring in by that time,

Petition of M^r Tench (concerning the Erecting of Water
Mills) read and allowed of, and thought by the whole house
to be a very Necessary and convenient Lawe, and therefore
ordered the same to be renewed.

The request of the Pet^r was Likewise granted, with an ord^r
for a Clause to be incerted in the said Act in favour of the s^d
Petitioner, according to the desire of his Petition.

Ordered that a bill be brought in for the Encourageing of
the breed of Horses.

Ordered (by way of Informacōn) that the Justices of euey
County p^sent a person to the Secretary to be their County
Clerk the house thinking th^t the properest meanes & way to
gett p^sons fitting & quallified to serve the Countrey.

Ordered that a Law be made for the killing of Wolves, and
the Encouragem^t for doeing the same is Left to the Cōmittee
of Lawes to Consider off.

Ordered that a bill be brought in against the Exportation
of Deere Skins either Raw or dressed, and the same refferred
to the Cōmittee of Lawes.

The house adjournes till to Morrow morning Nine of the
Clock.
