settling an Allowance for the Support of the Governm^t and
being willing to informe themselves of the yearly Revenue of
the Imposition of the 2^d p hhd doe therefore humbly desire
your Ex^{ncy} will be pleased to p^rmitt M^r LLewellin to come
downe to this house for some small time, and that he may
bring along with him the severall Accounts by him taken from
the Navall Officers of this Province, to the End they may be
rightly informed about the same.
