That the Act for 14^d Tonnage carryed such a Clogg along
 wth it, contrary to the intent of the body of the Law, therefore
 thought it properest that it should accrue to the Uses of the
 first intent. M^r Speaker answeres th^t if he had knowne the
 Subject matter vpon which the Conferrence was desired, he
 should haue Consulted the house to giue answe^r to the same
 and therefore can att present say little therein till he receiue
 instructions from the house.

That the Act limiting the Expences of the Justices of the
 Provinciaall Court he thought it to be Unequal that those Gen-
 tlemen of the Councill that were likewise Justices of the
 Provinciaall Court should not be allowed equall to the afd
 Justices left to Consideration of the house.

That the Act for Impost of 4^d a Gallon vpon Liquo^{rs} be
 Considered off.

That the Act for Navall Officers ffees, his Ex^{ncy} thanked
 them for settleing the 30^s p Shipp vpon him, but withall told
 them that they Cutt off part of the same againe in alloweing
 noe thing to the Navall Officer referred to Consideration.

That an Act had been sent downe from that board, for-
 bidding Tradè wth the Indians without Lycence from the
 Gouvernor to which his Ex^{ncy} tells them that Board had
 receiued noe answe^r as yett; therefore desires they would
 be mindfull of the same.

That in the Act for publishing of the Lawes, he tells them
 there is noe fee ascertained.

M^r Speaker Answeres that they haue ordered a fee of
 1200^{lb} to^b the w^{ch} his Ex^{ncy} does say is too small, & therefore
 desires them to Consider furth^r of it.

The which Conferrence being Ended, M^r Speaker wth the
 rest of the members returne to the State house, and take
 their places.
