10<sup>thly</sup> Memorandum. That a new Law be made Touching hoggs and markeing Cattle.

11<sup>thly</sup> Resolved that an Act for Continueing of peace w<sup>th</sup> & proteccōn of &c That the last Enacting Clause & pviso be repeal'd if thought Convenient.
