Whereas Ensigne W^m Davis Giles Hasleham & John Pate with divers others, Inhabitants upon or neere the Cliftes in Calvert County have contrived a mutinous & seditious paper tending to the subversion of the Governm^t of this Province under the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary & destruction of the Peace of the People. And the same with force & terror of Armes have Published att the head of the Company Comanded by Majo^r Henry Jowles, threatning the said Majo^r with their Gunns cocked & p^rsented These are therefore in the name of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary to Will & Comānd all Officers Millitary & Civill & all House-Keepers & other the good People of this Province to Apprehend the said Ensigne W^m Davis Giles Hasleham & John Pate & them Safely to bring to the Garrison att Mattapany Sewall there to be kept in safe Custody, strictly Charging & Comāding all house keepers & all other the good People of this Province not to harbour comfort aid or Assist the said Davis Hasleham & Pate or any of them as they will Answer the contrary att their uttmot perills And forasmuch as many well meaning People of this Province may have been seduced by the said Davis Hasleham & Pate to Joyne with them in the Publicacōn of the said paper Itt is hereby Declared Published & Proclaimed that the Governm^t will not take notice of that Crime in any other person then the said Davis Hasleham & Pate Provided they render themselves to the Deputy Lievtent^t or some one of his Lordshipps Councell for this Province within foureteene dayes, & shall discover the Cuncello^{rs} Contrivers & writers of the said paper Given att the City of S^t Maryes under the great Seale of this Province of Maryland this first
