And wee doe hereby revoake adnull & make voyd all former  
Comissions heretofore att any tyme given unto the said  
Thomas Notley or any others in relation to all or any the  
Offices Powers or Authorityes hereby granted And all &  
every power & powers Authority & Authoritys thing &  
things in them every or any of them given granted mencōned p. 118  
or contained hereby declareing the same to be revoaked  
adnulled & made voyd to all intents & purposes imediatly  
from & after the publishing of these p'sents within our said Pro-
