Whereas att the laying of the publick Levy of this Province

for these two yeares last past, itt hath been the custome & practice of severall the Sheriffes win this Province to bring in rebatem^{ts} for severall persons returned in their lists of Titheables alleadging that they are runaway or dyed insolvent which is thought to happen meerly through the remisnes & negligence of the Sheriffes themselves not takeing care to secure or collect the same in due tyme, prsumeing that they shall be allowed for the same in the publick levy. For p. 125 prvencon whereof for the future & to the end that the Sheriffes may be the more circumspect & diligent in the Execucon of their Office for the tyme to come I doe hereby (by & with the advice & consent of his Lord PS Councell) charge & comand all & singuler the Justices of each respective County to perfect the gen" lists of all the Titheables within their respective Countyes before such tyme as they shall transmitt the same to the Governor Councell & Delegates att the laying the publick Levy, exempting no persons therein from paying Levyes, except only such as are bona fide under the age of sixteen yeares & poor indigent persons that have no visible Estates not able to worke or otherwise uncapable to pay the same And I doe hereby (by & with the advice & con-Notley sent aforesaid) further publish & declare that every list so returned as aforesaid shall stand for good & shall in no wise be altered corrected or amended neither shall any Sheriffe or other person whatsoever be allowed for any persons in their County runaway or otherwise contrary to the said List after the same shall be returned as aforesaid from the Justices of their respective County Given att the Citty of St Maryes under the great Seale of this Province this second day of Octobr in the second yeare of the dominion of the right Honble Charles &c over this Province Annoq Dom. 1677.
