Whereas I am given to understand by a letter received from Cap<sup>t</sup> Thomas Walker high Sheriffe of Som<sup>r</sup>sett County, as also by the deposicōn of W<sup>m</sup> Keene of the same County that there is lately a barberous murder comitted by some Indians att the house of David Williams of the said County upon himselfe & his whole ffamily These are therefore to will & require as also strictly to charge & comānd you Col W<sup>m</sup> Coleborne Comand<sup>t</sup> in chiefe of all his Lord<sup>sh</sup> foote militia in the County of Som<sup>r</sup>sett aforesaid, upon sight hereof (if occasion shall require to sumōn all the forces of the said County under your comānd to be in readines well & compleatly fixed for the defence & safeguard of your County att an hours warning upon paine of death And if you shall see just reason & occasion requires more men & amunition for the defence & safeguard of yo<sup>r</sup> County then yo<sup>r</sup> County of itt selfe can procure Signifie the same to me together with what quantity of men Armes & Amūnition more the defence & safeguard of your County shall require with all expedition, & itt shall upon  
 p. 130 first notice given by you be provided & sent to you for your assistance in which your proceedings you are hereby also willed & required to take the advice of M<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Stevens & Cap<sup>t</sup> Thomas Walker of your County to whom you are upon such urgent occasions to addres your selfe & to whom I have wrote to afford you all aid & assistance as to their advice therein to the utmost of their abilities And further if itt shall so happen that the whole Nation of Indians are in a generall
