Given und<sup>r</sup> my hand and Seale this Eleaventh Day of October in the third yeare of the Dominion of the R<sup>tt</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles &c<sup>a</sup> over this Province Annoq Domini 1678:

To Coll: George Wells Command<sup>r</sup> in chiefe of all his L<sup>s</sup>pp<sup>s</sup> Militia of ffoote in Baltemore County, or in his absence to Majo<sup>r</sup> Thom: Long of the same County, in the absence of the said Long. to Cap<sup>t</sup> John Waterton, and in the absence of the said Waterton to the next Military Officer in the s<sup>d</sup> County either of Horse or ffoote, to be putt in Execution This

The same ord<sup>rs</sup> mutatis mutandis Directed to Cap<sup>t</sup> Ninion Beale at the head of Pottuxen River, as also to L<sup>t</sup> Coll: Thomas Tailer of Anne Arrundell County (with an additionall clause at the latter End requireing him to appoint some pson or psons in s<sup>d</sup> County whom he should think fitt to take charge of the County in his absence at the Assembly & to put the said ord<sup>rs</sup> in Execution;) And to Cap<sup>t</sup> Randolph Brandt in Charles County limiting his troope to range noe higher then the Pascattoway ffort.

At a Councill held at John Bakers house at the Citie of S<sup>t</sup> Maries the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of October in the third yeare of the Dominion of the R<sup>tt</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles &c<sup>a</sup> over this Province Annoq Domini 1678:
