Was then read by Robert Ridgely Clerke of the Council  
the foregoing Three Comissions and Instruccōns for his Excel-  
lency & Instruccōns for his Excellency and Council, and the  
same Examined by his Excellency & Council.

James Lewis brought by the Sheriff of St Maryes County  
before his Excellency & Council by virtu of the hono<sup>ble</sup> the  
Chancelor<sup>s</sup> warrant, for speaking mutinous and seditious  
words. Ordered that the said Lewis be bound over to the  
Provinciall Court to answe<sup>r</sup>e the same.

The last will and Testament of William Hattoft deceased  
being Exhibited to his Excellency & Council, desiring their  
order about the same.

Ordered that Letters Testamentary be thereupon issued  
according to usuall forme out of the Secretaryes office in the  
name of Edward ffitzherbert Esq<sup>r</sup> & Caleb Baker the Exe-  
cuto<sup>rs</sup> therein named, they giving security according to usuall  
forme in One hundred Thowsand pounds of Tobacco, to  
indemnify the Judge for probate of wills &c.

Robert Hawkins brother of John Hawkins deceased coming  
over into this Country, made his Claime to his said Brothers  
Estate as heire, and desired the L<sup>tes</sup> of Adcōn upon the said  
Estate comitted to one John Damrell might be quashed.

Ordered by the board that a Citation be issued out of  
the Secretaryes office retornable the 13<sup>th</sup> day of ffebruary next  
directed to the said Damrell, thereby comand<sup>ing</sup> him to  
appeare before his Excellency & Council and show cause if  
any he have why the said L<sup>tes</sup> of Admcōn to him graunted  
upon the said Hawkins Estate should not be Vacated upon  
Record.
