The humble Peticōn of Garrett Vansweeringen Sheweth,  
That yo<sup>r</sup> Pet<sup>r</sup> at the laying of the Leavy Anno 1677: was allowed by your Hono<sup>rs</sup> and the members of the Lower house of Assembly the summe of Thirteene Thousand Twenty & two pounds of tobacco to be p<sup>d</sup> by Thomas Tailler High Sheriff of Dorchester County out of the Publick Leavy in the said County w<sup>ch</sup> said summe the said Thomas Tailler hath recd: and yo<sup>r</sup> Pet<sup>r</sup> Did expect to have recd: the same for the paying of yo<sup>r</sup> Peticōners Debts as especially for being security
