Ordered that the Sheriff of S<sup>t</sup> Maries County forthwith send an express to John Shankes of the same County with an ord<sup>r</sup> of Councell relateing to the Choptico Indians herewith given him and that the same Messenger also after Delivery thereof immediately goe to James Smallwood of Charles County & Deliver unto him another ord<sup>r</sup> of Councell relateing to the Mattawoman and Nanjemy Indians with all expedition possible, And for the more speedy & better effecting thereof the said Sher. of S<sup>t</sup> Maries County is hereby empowered to press man and Horse for that purpose. Dated the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of June in the fourth yeare of the Dominion of the R<sup>tt</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles &c<sup>a</sup> Annoq Dmi. 1679:
