locus sigilli These are to Lycence Robert Ridgely of S^t Maryes County att his plantacōn att Wiccocomico river in Som^rsett County to trade with any Indian or Indians whatsoever for any Corne Skins or other Comodities not prohibited by Act of Assembly And further to give the said Robert liberty of keeping an Indian or Indians to hunt for him upon his said Plantacōn in Som^rsett County aforesaid And for so doing this shall be his sufficient warrant Given under my hand & Seale att Armes this twelfth day of July in the fourth year of our Dominion over our said Province of Maryland And in the year of our Lord God 1679.
