That for the space of neere twenty yeares last past Randall Revell of Somersett County haveing obtained a grant for 3000 Acres of Land and by the Artifice of Coll Scarborough his then Partner in the said Land hath in the Survey then made mentioned the naturall bounds of a Neck of Land wherein is presumed to be 10: or 12000 Acres of Land, by reason of w^{ch} uncertaine bounds and the large pretended Title of the said Randall and his false Clamo^{rs} severall of yo^r L^{spps}: good of this Province have been Defeated of severall settle^{ts} much to the Diminution of yo^r L^{spps}: Rents. And yo^r L^{spps} Peticōner with severall others prepareing to Peticōn yo^r L^{spp}: for a warrant of Resurvey to lay out the said Revells 3000 Acres in hopes they might have leave to Pattent the remainder according to the vsuall forme and Custome of yo^r L^{spps}: Province, And the said Randall haveing notice given him of the faire intentions of yo^r L^{spps}: Peticōners, The said Randall hath besought yo^r L^{spp}: for an ord^r to lay out the said Land to his owne vse but never hath p^{se}cuted the same according to the Intention thereof but delays the same, thereby further defrauding yo^r L^{spp}: of yo^r Rents, and Deterring yo^r L^{spps} people from Inhabiting the same.

Yo^r L^{spps}: Peticōner does most humbly pray that yo^r L^{spp}: will please to command y^r Secry: to grant yo^r Pet^{rs} a warr^t to lay out the said Revells 3000 Acres and that he may have leave (makeing good rights accordingly) to take up the vacant Land and that he may have leave to Pattent the same in his owne Name und^r the vsuall Rents and Services of yo^r L^{spps}: Province, And yo^r Pet^r as in Duty bound shall ever pray &c^a Whereupon

Ordered that Speciall warrant issue forth of the Secrys Office to the Deputy Survey^r of Somersett County, to lay out and Resurvey the Land of Randall Revell in the said County according to the true bounds thereof and to certifie the certain Quantity of Acres therein contened into the Secrys Office with all expedition
