Benjamin Rozer with the advice and assistance of such and soe many able men of his County as himself shall think fitt, be and he is hereby empowered and fully Authorised to call before him the said Indians and treat with them concerning the premisses, and withall to acquaint them that it is the opinion of his L<sup>spp</sup>: and the Councill that all the neighbouring Indians unite themselves to One place, and that Pascattoway is the most Convenient place for that purpose. Coll Rozer to transmitt his proceedings herein unto his L<sup>spp</sup>: and the Councell with all expedition.
