W^{ch} Letter being read and the Contents thoroughly weighed and Considered by his L^{spps} and his Councill here present it is concluded most Safe for the Pascattoway Indians and Mattawomans to remoove themselves their wives and Children to Nantecoke for some time and that for severall p. 115 reasons then argued w^{ch} is resolved to be Signified to the said Indians in as few words as may be for preventing any mistakes in the Delivery thereof by the Interpreter M^r John Stone who is ordered to Communicate the same unto them in manner following viz.

By the Lord Propry & Councill

May 22th 1680:

Ordered that the Emperor of Pascattoway be given to undrstand ffirst

1: That his L^{spp} desires nothing more then that he and his people be Safe from their Enemies.

- 2; That his L^{spp} is certain that if all the Choptico Indians and the Mattawomans were at Pascattoway with the Emperor they are not able to fight the Sinniquos & Susquehannoghs who are above One Thousand men
- 3: That the Virginians will not believe that the Sinniquos murd: their people, and doe say that all the murd¹⁵ committed on that side of Pottomack are done by the Pascattoways.
