At what time was taken into Consideration the last Commissions granted by his L^{supp} to the Comiss^{rs} of the severall respective Counties within this Province for tryall of Causes w^{ch} was found Deficient in severall particulars and therefore ordered that new Commissions issue to each County empowering the Commission^{rs} thereof to heare and Determine all causes or Actions of Debt whatsoever all Actions of trespass upon the Case ariseing for goods, wares, or other things delivered money or goods lent without limitation to any summe or Quantity whatsoever as also all actions of trespass Quare clausum fregit whereon titles to Land Doe not Depend, Actions of Detinue, sur trover and Replevin, Actions of Covenant wast assault menace battery and Imprisonm^t and Actions of slander for words spoken; where the Damage laid in the Declaration drawne and filed in and upon such Actions as afores^d doe not exceed the summe of three thousand pounds of tobacco, And that a Clause be inserted in the said Commission to Authorise and Empower one of the Justices of the Provinciaall Court inhabiting and resideing within the said
