You are hereby ordered to summon John Story, John Bennett
and James Taylor of your County that all excuses sett
apart they be and psonally appeare before his L^{spp} the R^{tt}
Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ry} and his Councill at the state house at p. 145
the City of S^t Maries on Tuesday next the fffifth Day of Octo-
ber whereof they are not to faile as they will answer the con-
trary at their perill and lett them have there with them this
precept. Dated the thirtieth Day of September 1880:

Severall Complaints haveing been exhibited to his L^{spp}:
against John Hawkins of Talbott County to whom a Commiss^o
had been formerly granted for hunting and takeing up wild
horses &c. It was ordered that the same be vacated by a
particular ord^r from this board to be Delivered to Cap^t Peter
Sayer for that purpose w^{ch} is as foll viz

By the Lord Prop^{ry} & Councill

Whereas Commission was formerly granted to John Haw-
kins of Talbott County to hunt for and take up wild horses,
and whereas severall Comp^{lts} and Informations against the
said Hawkins have been exhibited to his L^{spp}. These are
therefore by ord^r of his said L^{spp} and his Councill to publish
pronounce and Declare the said Commission to be void Null
and vacated to all intents and purposes strictly charging &
Commanding the said Hawkins to take due Cognizance
hereof and not to act any further by vertue or und^r pretence
of the same as he will answer the Contrary at his perill Dated
the fffifth Day of October in the fffifth year of the Dominion
of the R^{tt} Hon^{ble} Charles &c. Annoq Dmi. 1680:
