It was ordered that the same be vacated by a particular ord^r from this board to be Delivered to Cap^t Peter Sayer for that purpose w^{ch} is as foll viz

By the Lord Prop^{ry} & Councill

Whereas Commission was formerly granted to John Hawkins of Talbott County to hunt for and take up wild horses, and whereas severall Complis and Informations against the said Hawkins have been exhibited to his L^{spp}. These are therefore by ord of his said L^{spp} and his Councell to publish pronounce and Declare the said Commission to be void Null and vacated to all intents and purposes strictly charging & Commanding the said Hawkins to take due Cognizance hereof and not to act any further by vertue or und pretence of the same as he will answer the Contrary at his perill Dated the ffifth Day of October in the ffifth yeare of the Dominion of the R^{tt} Honble Charles &c. Annoq Dmi. 1680:
