That the said John Tennisson forthwith deliver unto his said wife or her ordrone good bed and furniture called by the name of her owne bed, all her weareing apparell, and allow her yearely for the time to come three hundred pounds of meate, three barrells of Corne and one Thousand pounds of tobacco for and towards her maintenance dureing her naturall life to be paid and allotted her in such part and place of this Province as she shall Desire and appoint, and that the said John Tennisson give good security for his true pformance of what is hereby required of him before the Honble William Digges Esqr who is hereby Authorised and empowered (at such time as he shall think fitt) to summon before him the said John Tennisson and take of him such security as aforesd such as he shall approove of
