Out of the Speciall trust and Confidence we have in your fidelity Circumspection courage care and good Conduct we have ordeined constituted and appointed as by these p<sup>r</sup>sents we doe ordeine constitute & appoint you the s<sup>d</sup> to be Capt<sup>a</sup> of a Troope of horse or Comp<sup>a</sup> of ffoote (as occasion shall require or shall be thought convenient) to be by you raised in Mattapony and Boquatanawton hundreds in the County aforesaid Wherefore the Soldiers of the s<sup>d</sup> Troope or Company to be by you raised as aforesaid you are to take into your care and Charge as Cap<sup>ta</sup> them to exercise and train up in the art of Warr and Military Discipline and in all thinges to act doe and p<sup>r</sup>forme as any Cap<sup>t</sup> of a Troope of horse or company of ffoote may or of Right ought to Doe to the Resistance of all our Enemies Suppression of all Mutinies, Insurrections Invasions and Rebellions whatsoever within this Province according to such orders Instructions and Directions as you shall from time to time receive from us or our L<sup>t</sup> Generall or other Chiefe Governo<sup>r</sup> for the time being, from Coll William Stevens of our said County of Somersett or from other your Superio<sup>r</sup> Officer, And we doe hereby strictly charge and Comānd all
