To have and to hold the said place and Office of Marshall unto the s^d Edmund Dennis for and dureing pleasure. Given und^r our hand and Seale at Armes the 22th Day of ffeb^{ry} in the Sixth yeare of our Dominion & Annoq Dmi One Thousand Six hundred and Eighty.

A Proclamation

Whereas for severall weighty and urgent Occasions & Affaires relateing to Our Self and the State and Defence of this our Province Wee did hold a generall Assembly at the City of S^t Maries the ffifteenth day of May in the first yeare of our Dominion &c. Annoq Domini One Thousand six hundred Seaventy Six, Which for divers considerations, Us thereunto mooveing wee did by severall prorogations continue & prorogue untill the twentieth Day of October then next ensueing, W^{ch} s^d Assembly the ffifteenth Day of November then next following we did prorogue untill the Second Tuesday in May then next following which upon the fourteenth Day of March then next ensueing wee did prorogue untill the last Tuesday in September then next ensueing w^{ch}
