Ind. Into Virginia to Coll Spencers and there made a Canooe

Int. Did all the rest of your Company here goe with you there?

Ind. all together.

Int. What other Indian saw you at Coll Spencers?

Ind. there came two men and two boyes to buy Cotton

Int. What Indians were they?

Ind. Nanjatico
