Page 11, line 43. "in Carads" = "Encourages." "Tomusts and woull." Undecipherable.

Page 12, line 5. "destroy" for "distrain."

Page 28, line 30. "Geel Gune." So in C. S. C. It should be "George Clymer." Morris, Clymer, and Walton were the Congressional Committee stationed at Philadelphia.

Page 155, line 5. "This State." A later copy has "Statia" (St. Eustatia), which is correct. See letter No. 166.

Page 189, line 24. "Tooth." An error of the scribe for "Tootell," sometimes written "Tootle."

Page 194, line 30. The first adoption of the Great Seal of the State.

Page 199, line 18. "Same purpose to." Some name omitted.

Page 256, line 3. "Tooth." See note above.

Page 282, line 19. "Tooth." See note above.

Page 298, line 21. "Yesterday." A mistake of the clerk. In the Journal this follows immediately after the record of June 21.
