Whereof faile not and for soe doeing this shall be your warrant

Dated at the s<sup>d</sup> City of S<sup>t</sup> Maries the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August in the Seaventh year of the Dominion of the R<sup>t</sup> hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles & c<sup>a</sup> Annoq Dmi. 1682:

By the Lord Prop<sup>ty</sup> A Proclamation

Whereas the R<sup>t</sup> hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>ty</sup> of this Province with intent to meete the good people of this Province in a Generall Assembly, And to have their advice concerning the urgent affaires of this Province, did by his Proclamation beareing Date the Tenth Day of July last past declare the Calling of a new Assembly to beginn and be holden at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Maries the Twelfth day of October next ensueing, and accordingly Comanded his Chancelo<sup>r</sup> of this Province to Issue out writts in due forme for that purpose which s<sup>d</sup> Twelfth day of October on which the s<sup>d</sup> Assembly should sitt being now at hand and the affaires of this Province not Absolutely Requireing the Convention or sitting of the s<sup>d</sup> Assembly soe soone; his L<sup>dsp</sup> for divers good Causes and Considerations him thereunto mooveing, hath thought fitt, and doth hereby fully resolve Determine and ordeine that the s<sup>d</sup> Generall Assembly be prorogued untill the four and Twentyeth day of October next ensueing the Date hereof; hereby Willing and Requireing all and Singular the Sheriffes of this Province to make
