Ordered That the said Sharpe and Webb are discharged from any further Attendance on this board.

I A B. doe sweare that I will be true & ffaithfull unto the R^t hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ry} of this Province and to his heires and successo^{rs} Lords and Prop^{rys} of this Province, and to his and their Leivetenant Gen^{ll} or Chiefe Governo^r for the time being, And I will well and faithfully serve his said L^{spp} in the Office of Justice of the Provinciall Court in all things that thereunto appertaines. Soe help me God &c
