fourthly. That the 14th febr^{ry} an Attachm^t was granted the
s^d Miller against the Estate of one William Bateman, by
vertue whereof the s^d Miller seized the s^d Estate, and made
sale thereof without any condemnation and also Seized all the
papers, amongst which was said to be a discharge from the
s^d Miller to the s^d Bateman of all debts dues and demands, M^r
Hosier did owne that Bateman had such a receipt (in Open
Court) from the s^d Miller but would not produce it; also M^r
Hosier did attach 1700^l: tob^o in the hands of M^r Hambleton
and 1000^l: tob^o of the s^d Ringolds in the hands of John Hussey,
by the title of Batemans Estate, but gives noe Acco^t thereof,
nor makes any Returne of the Attachm^t as touching the s^d
Tobacco, but soe much as cann be called Batemans Estate
properly belongs to the Orphan of William Stanley decd:

fifthly. July 25th 1682: being p^rmeditated before at the
house of the s^d Miller. All Orphans Estates reall and psonall
were appraised by Jury (Stanleys Orphans excepted) and the
charge arising thereof was said to be 10 or 12000^l: tob^o but
noe law produced for that unnecessary charge.

Sixthly. August 28th 1683: All Actions depending in the
Court were lett fall by order of the s^d Wicks Hosier and
Miller

Septemb^r 25th 1683: Noe full Court, therefore adjourned by
the said Justices Wickes Hosier and Miller.

These reasons (though the s^d Ringold could shew much
more) he hopes are sufficient for not joyneing with the s^d
Comission^s in their unjust illegall way of proceedings Suf-
fered and done, beside the severall absurdities & abuses
offered him in relation to his Office, All which he leaves to his
L^{sp}s Consideration, and prays his L^{sp}s: writt of Ease in that
affaire.

Hosier, & M^r Miller (M^r Evett being dead) be turned out of
