Ordered that the pet<sup>r</sup> Entring into Recognizance before the hon<sup>ble</sup> the Commissaryes or Secrys of this Province or either of them, in manner as the same is usually given in the Provinciall Court, for his future good behaviour from time to time as shall be thought convenient; The pet<sup>r</sup> may be discharged in Court: And for the ffine his L<sup>SP</sup> is willing the same shall be suspended untill such time as his carriage and good comportm<sup>t</sup> shalt deserve further favour from his L<sup>SP</sup>: to remitt the same.

His L<sup>SP</sup>: mooves the Advice of his Council concerning some Instructions to be left with a particular Council his L<sup>SPP</sup> designed to constitute in his absence to heare and determine all matters of Land and Acts of grace and favour therein

Whereupon Resolved and ordered that the Clk of the Council make inspection into former precedents, and make report to this board what hath been usually heretofore done in such cases; and also prepare a Commission for such a Council to be assigned by his L<sup>SP</sup> distinct from the Council of State, His L<sup>SPP</sup> having nominated the hon<sup>ble</sup> Coll Henry Darnall, Coll William Digges Maj<sup>r</sup> Nicholas Sewall & John Darnall Esq<sup>r</sup> his L<sup>SPPS</sup> Cuncello<sup>rs</sup> thereunto Assigned.
