Hereby also ordeining that they the said Coll Henry Darnall, Coll William Digges, Majo<sup>r</sup> Nicholas Sewall, and John Darnall Esq<sup>r</sup> or any three of them shall be a sufficient and compleate Councill for the heareing and determineing the matters aforesaid. Giveing and granting hereby unto the said Coll: Henry Darnall, Coll William Digges, Maj<sup>r</sup> Nicholas Sewall, and John Darnall Esq<sup>r</sup> or any three of them as aforesaid full power and Authority to sitt and hold Councill when where, and as often as to them shall seeme meete for the end and purpose aforesaid, And to grant to the Inhabitants of our s<sup>d</sup> Province, and others Suito<sup>rs</sup> in such Cases, such favours benefitts and priviledges as have been usually given and condescended unto by us in Councill, according to such ord<sup>rs</sup> Instructions and directions as Wee have already given or shall hereafter think fitt & necessary to give unto them. Hereby ratifyeing confirmeing and allowing for firme good and valid whatsoever shall be done or granted by our said Councill pursuant to their said In-
