Memd: the ffour and Twentyeth day of June in the nineth yeare of the Dominion of the Rt honble Charles &c: over this Province Annoq Dmi: 1684 came before me John Darnall Esq Secretary and one of his Ldsps Justices of the Provincial Court, Robert Carvile of the County of St Maries, and acknowledged himself to owe and be justly indebted unto the Rt honble the Lord Propry of this Province in the full and just summe of ffourty pounds Lawfull currant money of England, To be leavyed of his goods & Chattells Lands and Tenemts upon condition foll; that if the said Robert Carvile shall well behave himself, and be of good abearance as well towards his Lsp: the said Lord Propry as to all and singular the good people of this Province, for and untill the next Provinciall Court to be holden for the said Lord Prop<sup>ry</sup> at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Maries, then the above Recognizance to be void and of none effect or else to stand in good force power and vertue in Law
