Liber R. uncured, and three greate hogs they killed then, and have taken away about Six barrills of Corne out of his Loft, and about 3 barrills of Corne out of the field, and made severall attempts to have broke into his house to have robb'd him, and lay sore upon him from 12 a Clock on the tenth Day untill 9 a Clock on the 11th Day

Upon the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of September Instant there came a greate party of Indians to the house of William Jones breakeing into his house, and takeing away all his goods to the value of 8000 w<sup>tt</sup> of tobacco and from Thomas Willson Clothes to the value of 2000 w<sup>tt</sup> of tobacco, and from William Hakes Clothes to the value of 400 w<sup>tt</sup> of tobacco, and from Richard Charfey Clothes to the value of 1000 w<sup>tt</sup> of tobacco besides severall hoggs of the said Jones's

At Capt<sup>n</sup> Ladds Quarter the Indians killed a Cow & two yearelings and at Samuel Magroothers they killed a Bull

You are hereby willed and Required immediately upon sight hereof to take a true Coppy from the Records of your County Court of all the proceedings against Capt<sup>2</sup> John Coode in relation to his insolent and contumacious carriage and behaviour there, and the process of the said Court thereupon; and the transcript thereof under your hand attested you are to transmitt to his L<sup>spp</sup> and Councill to the Clerk of the Councill directed at the City of S<sup>1</sup> Maries with all possible p. 262 Speed. Whereof faile not Dated the 29th Day of September in the Sixth yeare of the Dominion of the R<sup>1</sup> honble. Charles &c. Annoq Domini 1681: Signed p ord<sup>1</sup>
