His L^{spp} by Coll Darnall then present represents to this board that one M^r Robert an Eastern Shore Indian and Brother to the Emperour of Nantecoke was then with his L^{spp} at Mattapony and bound over to the Emperour with presents from the Pascattoway Indians Desireing Assistance from his Indians, w^{ch} the said Robert hath acquainted his L^{spp} the Nantecoke Indians are inclinable to afford them, if his L^{spp} will give them leave to send over some of their men for that purpose, to which his L^{spp} signifies his inclination and consent but desires the approbation and advice of his Councill w^{ch} issued in the following ord^r of this board. viz.
