And the said Deponent further deposeth that he heard that there was a warrant issued out by Coll Henry Darnall & Maj^r Nicholas Sewall directed to the Sheriff of Calvert County (in which County the Kings Ketch lay) for the apprehending the body of the s^d Coll George Talbott, and secureing him till he were delivered by due course of Law, and that after the said warrant issued wee went aboard the s^d Ketch, and to the best of this Dep^{ts} Remembrance, the sayd Coll Darnall or Maj^r Sewall did tell the said Cap^t that such warr^t was gone out, and that there would be some p^{rs}ons come on board to demand the prisoner accordingly

Anthony Underwood aged twenty five yeares or thereabouts deposeth as followeth

That I the said Anthony was sent for the first day of November to the house of Christopher Rousby Esq^r and when I came there, I understood by the said Rousbys Servants that there Master was killed on board a Ketch then rideing about two miles within the mouth of Pottuxen River over ag^t the said Rousby's Landing; which said Ketch This Depon^t was informed belonged to his Maj^{ty} our Sovereigne Lord the King, and that one Thomas Allen was Command^r of the same, on the morrow being Sunday the said Allen sent a boate to fetch this Deponent aboard, and this Deponent was carried on board in the said boate, and when I came on board the said Ketch, I p. 174
saw Coll Talbott most inhumanely loaded with Irons, and enquireing the reason of the Cap^t he told me he the said Talbott had killed M^r Rousby on board, and that he was resolved to carry him for Virginia, to receive his tryall for the fact there, This Dep^t did then advise Cap^t Allen as his ffriend to have a care what he did, and further told him that the prisoner ought to be tryed where the fact was Committed; upon which discourse came on board the hon^{ble} Coll Henry Darnall, and Maj^r Nicholas Sewall two of the Dep^{ty} Gov^{no}^{rs} und^r the R^t hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ty} and did then and there demand the body of the s^d Talbott in the name of my Lord Prop^{ty} to be delivered to them in ord^r to receive his tryall, and that Justice might be done according to Law, To which Allen
