

said Lawes or Acts relateing to the advancem^t of Trade, and raising of Townes within this Province be with all vigour and strictness observed, and the transgresso^{rs} thereof severely prosecuted, and that all such p^{ersons} as shall at any time after the publishing this Proclamation p^{re}sume to report or any way publish or declare that the Governm^t is indifferent in the advancem^t of Trade or propagateing of Townes according to the s^d Act, or that the designe thereof will fall, shall be p^{er}secuted against and punished as Divulgers of false news; And it is further declared that the Sheriff of each respective County in this Province doe cause this Proclamation to be read and published in the most publick & convenient places within their precincts, and that all p^{ersons} whatsoever doe take due cognizance thereof.

Given at the City of S^t Maries under the greate Seale of the s^d Province of Maryland this sixth day of March in the Tenth yeare of his L^{sp}s Dominion &c. Annoq Dmi One thousand Six hundred Eighty and ffour

Ordered that Capt^a John Osbourne of Som^rsett County proceed to survey lands within the bounds limited in his Com^{is}sion from Coll George Talbott late Survey^r Gen^l of this Province and make returne of his Certificates thereof as formerly untill May Court next and then that both he and Maj^r Thomas Taylor of Dorchester County be and p^{ersonally} appeare both of them before this board, in ord^r to the limitting and ascertaineing of their Commissions, and setting forth each mans bounds and precincts.

Ordered also that in the meane time the said Maj^r Taylor and Samuel Cooper of Sommersett County proceed likewise in surveying of lands according to their Commissions from the s^d Coll George Talbott, and returning their Certificates thereof to the Dep^{ties} Liev^{ts} upon the conditions & tearmes in their s^d Commissions mentioned untill May Court next, and then their bounds to be more certainly assigned them.
