James Ringold's petition

To the hon^{ble} his L^{sps} Councill appointed &c.
The humble petition of James Ringold of Kent County
Humbly sheweth

That at a Provincially Court held at the City of S^t Maries the
ffourth day of March Anno Dmi. 1684: One Michael Miller
obtained judgem^t ag^t your pet^r upon an acc^{on} of Trespass
upon the case to the damages of two and twenty thousand
pounds of tobacco and costs of suite, which s^d judgem^t was
obtained contrary to Law, and therefore is manifestly Erro-
neous (as may hereafter appeare) to the greate damage of
your pet^r

Your pet^r therefore humbly prayes your Hono^{rs} to award
him his L^{dsps} writt of Erro^r upon the judgem^t aforesaid to the
Justices of the Provincially Court to be directed, requiring
them to send to the upper house of the next generall
Assembly, the transcript of the Record process proceedings
and judgem^t aforesaid, that inspection being thereinto had, his
said L^{sp} in the said upper house of Assembly, may cause to be
done therein, what of right and according to the Lawes of this
Province, ought to be done; and likewise his L^{sps} writts of
Sciri facias, and supersedeas thereupon, according to an Act
of Assembly in that case made and provided. Your s^d Pet^r
givinge security therefore.

And your Pet^r as in duty bound shall ever pray &c.
