Came M^r Edward Batson of Calvert County formerly appointed Deputy Survey^r for Calvert County aforesaid, and humbly mooved their Hono^{rs} to a certain agreement for the said Office.

Ord^r to enjoy the same at 2500^l p ann.

Ordered that the said Batson have exercise and enjoy the same together with all the ffees profitts and perquisites thereof to his owne proper use and behoofe for the space of one whole yeare from the time of his being first assigned thereunto, for and in consideration of the summe of two thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco to be paid to his L^{sp} the R^t hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ty} or other person or persons appointed by his L^{sp} to receive the same to such use and uses as he shall think fitt.

Cap^t Jn^o Osbournes Com^{on} confirmed

Ordered that a Commission for Deputy Survey^r Granted by Coll George Talbott late Survey^r Gen^{ll} of this Province unto Cap^t John Osbourne of Som^rsett County the 17th day of October 1684: and every clause thereof (except onely what has been since granted to Samuel Cooper of the same County be and is hereby confirmed.

M^r Edward Pye Coll of ffoote in Charles County.

Ordered that the charge of the Militia of ffoote in Charles County be committed to Coll Edward Pye of the same County and that he have Comm^{on} accordingly in the roome of Coll W^m Chandler decd:
