Lib. R. R. R. for the future upon w<sup>ch</sup> and upon condition of her promise wholly to desert and forsake the Company of him whom she last married, and cleave to her s<sup>d</sup> former husband M<sup>r</sup> Robert Thompson onely, with him soberly & honestly to live, It is considered that she be acquitted of the punishm<sup>t</sup> due to her upon the judgem<sup>t</sup> & sentence afores<sup>d</sup> as to the corporall punishm<sup>t</sup> of burning in the hand, and ordered that pardon be drawne accordingly.
